



UPASS Opt-Out Form

Students who are taking one on-campus credit course at Camosun are automatically assessed the \$20.25/month U-Pass. The Camosun College Student Society and BC Transit have agreed to allow students to opt out of the UPASS for the following reasons: This opt out must be processed within 30 days of the start of a semester/term.

- Students with Disabilities where they can demonstrate their necessity to commute to/from Camosun by automobile other than BC Transit fixed route or handy Dart services.
 - Requires documentation of a *Disability Parking Permit*, or a Dr. Certificate.
- Students who already hold an annual BC Bus Pass, a Pro pass, or U-Pass.
 - Requires a photocopy of the bus pass.
 - Students who are enrolled at UVic must opt out of the U-Pass at UVic in Fall/Winter.
 - Students who have a Bus Pass provided to BC Transit employees or their family members are not allowed to opt-out of the U-Pass. This was stipulated by BC Transit.
- Students on a co-op work term located outside the Greater Victoria Area.
 - This must be processed by the Co-op office.
- Students studying via distance or takes only one course and lives outside the Greater Victoria Area.
 - Requires proof of registration and residency.
