Due to the ongoing fighting in Syria Waseem explained that he has been working with the Starfish project for sometime to raise funds to bring his brother and sister in-law along with their two children to Canada from a refugee camp in Lebanon because they have been displaced from their home in Syria and are in need of a stable and safe environment to raise their children

Whereas one of our members brother and his family are refugees in Lebanon; and Whereas there current living situation is unsatisfactory and not stable; and

Whereas the Intercultural Association of Victoria has commenced fundraising to bring this family to Victoria and has raised \$18,500 of the needed \$43,000 to sponsor the brother, his wife, and two daughters; therefore
