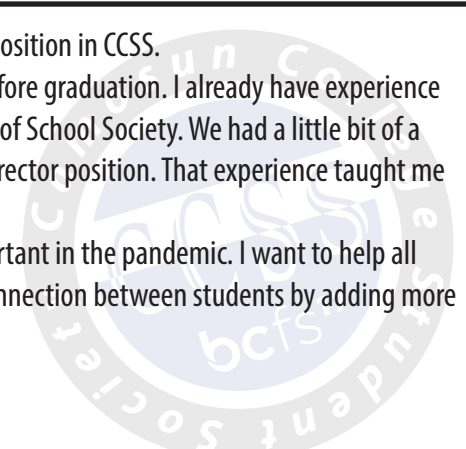


Melaniia Frolova

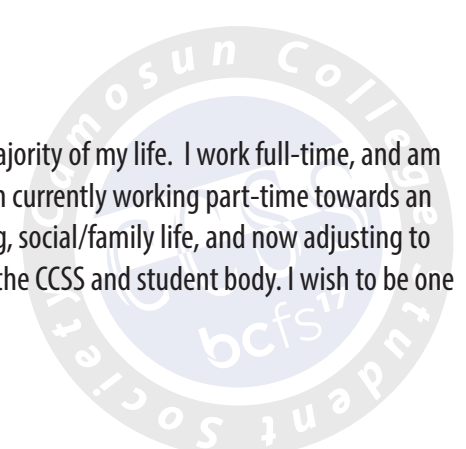
